



FAQ

Q: Is this an OCPS Partners in Education approved program?

A: It sure is! This program brings an amazing recycling and fundraising opportunity to your school.

Q: How does our school make money from this program?

A: Every quarter your school will receive an easy to read report of how much your bin collected/diverted from landfills, along with a check for \$0.10/lb for all collected items. Checks will be made payable to the Foundation for OCPS schools, the memo will contain your school name. Other notes: such as pick up instructions, servicing hours, collection bin is behind a locked gate, etc.

Q: How big is the bin?

A: The bin is stainless steel, will take up less than 1/4 of a parking space, and it is made in the USA.

Q: What do we have to do to maintain the bin?

A: Absolutely nothing. We ask only that you promote recycling to students and families at your school. Charity Recycling provides templates for some great ways to get the word out: email blasts, Twitter posts, Facebook posts, and announcements/ flyers for backpacks.

Q: How will Charity Recycling Service know where to place the bin at our school?

A: We will send you a site plan with two options clearly marked on it. Check the option you prefer, and the bin will be placed at that location. You may also request a different location, some examples are: in a parking spot, in the grass near the car pool lane, and most importantly, somewhere visible to the community.

Q: When will we get our recycling bin?

A: Once the signup form is submitted and a spot has been chosen your bin will be delivered in approximately 15 business days, on a first come, first served basis.

Q: Do I have to meet with the Charity Recycling Service driver to accept the bin?

A: As much as we love meeting our OCPS school partners, it is not necessary.

Q: What are some examples of acceptable items to recycle?

A: Acceptable items include Men's, women's, children's, athletic, casual, formal, jeans, jackets, shirts, hats, jewelry, purses, belts, etc. ANYTHING that your family no longer needs and is in useable condition can go into the bin.

Q: How often will our bin be serviced?

A: Each bin is equipped with sensors that tell us when it needs to be emptied. If you ever need an extra pickup, please call the CRS Service line: 800-459-1256.
